BABY'S FIRST ROOM

Organise your baby's nursery so that daily activities like sleeping, feeding, playing and changing are easily performed. Try and choose a chest of drawers that doubles up as a changing table. The cot is the central point of the nursery so ensure it is durable and large enough to work right until the child transitions to a bed. A cot mobile, soft rug to put your baby on for tummy time and an accessible dustbin are other essentials.
